Brand & Avery Roundabout Project Update

Work has officially begun on the roundabout project at Avery Road and Brand Road. The roundabout is scheduled to be complete by October 2017. Intermittent lane restrictions at the intersection for utility work are now underway. Flaggers will be on site to direct traffic as needed, and travel will be permitted in all four directions during this utility work. Short delays are possible. We will do our best to keep you updated on

lane closures as we receive information from the city. At this point, we know that Avery Road south of Brand Road may be closed soon, within two weeks. Indian Run is currently seeking to fill the position of Parents' Morning Out INDIAN RUN Coordinator. Children in the Parents' Morning Out (PMO) program are 2 years old. The PMO ministry provides free play, sensory table, reading stories, creating artwork, singing, dancing, and large muscle play while helping children to develop socially with

their peers. The Coordinator is responsible for leading and administering the program - as well as teaching. This is a part-time position of 15 hours per week from September through June and 5 hours per week from June through August. Ouglified candidates must be able to understand preschool and elementary age learning characteristics, create and follow curriculum, and relate well with children and adult leaders. Candidates must also be well-founded in Christian beliefs and passionate about children's ministry.
