Roundabout Project Update...Next Phase Begins

Crews are paving the intersection of Avery and Brand TODAY, October 6 and tomorrow, October 7. There will be interruptions to the southbound Avery Road during paving. There may be times that Avery Road will not be open in either direction. During paving, east-west traffic on Brand

Road will be maintained throughout the intersection with temporary signals and flaggers.

The project is expected to be finished by the end of October, but there is still work to be done! Here's what drivers can expect next week:

- North of Brand Road: Avery Road will be closed in both directions for approximately 200 feet. Detour signs will direct traffic to use Glick Road to Muirfield Drive back to Brand Road or Avery Road.
- South of Brand Road:
 - Northbound Avery Road will remain closed
 - o Southbound Avery Road will open south of Brand Road except during paving operations.
- Brand Road: Remains open for east-west travel with one-lane, two-way traffic maintained by temporary traffic signals.

Memory Verse: "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much." Luke 16:10a, NIV **Key Question:** How can you best use your time? Kids are just starting to become aware of time. We'll help kids begin to realize that we only have so much time, so how we use it matters to God. Kids will wrestle through the ways they spend their time now and figure out what needs to change to use their time wisely. Really, this is a question we hope small group leaders and parents ask themselves as they lead their kids. Everyone can benefit by taking a look at how they're spending the time God has given to them.

With that in mind, we continue looking at stewardship with another Psalm. In Psalm 90:12, Moses writes, Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom, (NIV). Moses reminds us that when we take time to think about the time God has given us, we have an opportunity to use our time wisely.

Bottom Line: Use your time wisely. We only have so much time while we're here on earth, but every day God gives us is a chance for us to do something that matters. We can waste our time or use it to do something significant. We pray that kids will make every moment they have count.
