If you're like most of us today, you're concerned about what you see on the evening news and wonder how violence could impact the lives of your family and friends. Perhaps you're confused about what the police, the school systems, or even your own company can do to stop the proliferation of violence. In an effort to fulfill our mission to "grow love" in our

community, we are inviting the public to join us for a special SECURITY 101 - Situational Awareness & Personal Defense Program on **Saturday, May 5 at 10am OR Thursday, May 10 at 7pm**. This one-hour program, led by special guest speaker Rick Colliver, is designed to answer many of your questions and help you identify and avoid potentially violent confrontations. *This is not just another active shooter class*,

but an opportunity to better

understand the essential elements of personal security and improve your understanding of your environment. In this program, you will learn: What is targeted violence? How can you create a risk-based security plan for your family or office? How can you become more situationally aware of your environment? How can you be a better observer of suspicious behaviors?
